THE CHURCH

The Parish Church of St Mary & All Saints, Chesterfield, is an ancient and iconic building. Parts of the present Church date back to the 13th Century and reflect the prosperity of that time. It was consecrated in 1234 and most of the building work was completed by 1360.

It is of cruciform design, measuring approximately 173ft (53m) long and 110ft (33m) wide across the transept, and has a most graceful interior.

THE SPIRE

The Church's world-famous 'Crooked Spire' dominates the skyline. The spire was constructed in wood between 1380 and 1400, and later covered with lead. Octagonal in plan, it is 228ft (70m) high and leans 9ft 8in (2.9m) from its true centre.

'THE FRIENDS' - WHO WE ARE

'The Friends' is a registered charity founded in 1942 with the objective of promoting "the restoration, maintenance, repair and improvement of the fabric, ornaments, vestments, furniture and furnishings of Chesterfield Parish Church".

Over the years, the work of 'The Friends' has helped fund projects both large and small. And now, at the request of the PCC, we are embarking on our most ambitious enterprise yet

- the updating and renewal of the interior lighting of the church.
